Database presentation

Brian Dixon went over some details pertaining to AFA registration online. He mentioned renaming some categories in order to make the system work more efficiently.

The CFF wants to use our system. He thinks he should set them up as a club within our own system so they can try it out without him having to do a whole lot of extra work.

The system can do other things to: manage referees, coaches, ... if we decided we'd like to do that down the road.

The EFC proposed that we increase the money paid for casino shifts to \$300. After discussion we decided to keep it at \$200.

The EFC also suggested we put more money into the high-performance fencers.

With the money we have available we decided to keep a 70/30 ratio of development to high-performance fencers respectively. The younger provincial team members represent the developing fencers and the national to international fencers represent the high performance fencers. Once athletes been identified as high-performance fencers they will split what money is available on equal basis.

Ranking

We need three events to constitute a circuit but we can post results for any events that we run.

We have some old scoring machines which we will give to any clubs if the clubs would like them.

It is possible that we will be able to track volunteers down the road. This may have repercussions for applications for grants.

Payment of club fees to online through the AFA system costs money each time the system is accessed (a fee is assessed by Moneris for each transaction). It's better to do this through a club entry system at this point and only pay the fee once.

We need data from the tournaments as soon as possible so that we can get this data into the AFA rankings as quickly as possible.
