Fencers may enter more than one event, but if a timing conflict occurs, they may be required to withdraw from an event.

If fewer than 6 fencers register in an event, organizers may mix the event. (Fencers will be contacted.)

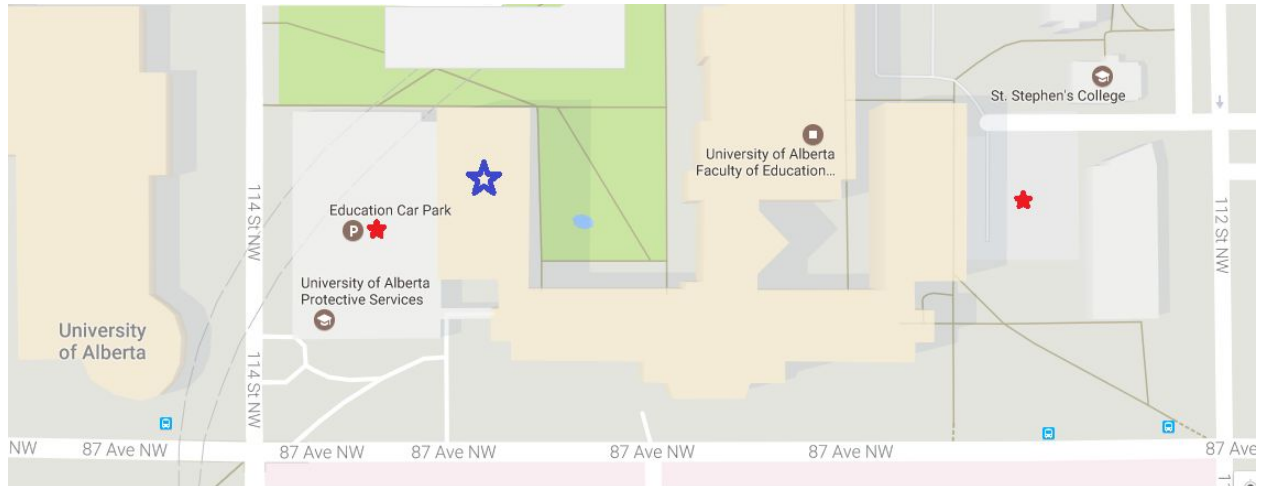
General Requirements –

All SENIOR events require fencers to have a valid CFF license, or membership with another federation.

Equipment:

- i. Mask – minimum 350 Newton or CE level 1 or equivalent; Masks must be fitted with a strap; electrified bib for U17 and up foil events.
- ii. Fencers must wear sous plastron, long socks, fencing breeches, and fencing jacket that overlap breeches, lame for foil and sabre, manchette or electric cuff in sabre, gloves – all do not need to be FIE.
- iii. Chestguard – female fencers must wear a chest guard.
- iv. 2 (two) working weapons – blades do not need to be maraging.
- v. 2 (two) working body wires.
- vi. For sabre and foil, 2 (two) mask clips (must be white).
- vii. Clean, indoor non-marking footwear.
