

Canada Winter Games Team Selection Procedures

- Athletes selected for the Canada Winter Games team will be announced shortly following the last qualifying event of the season, and no later than December 15, 2022. Fencing will take place during Week 2 of the Canada Winter Games, from February 27 – March 5, 2023.
- Athletes will be selected from the current appropriate age group - Those who qualify for the Cadet age group for the 2022-2023 season (born 2006 or later).
- Qualifying events will be held between March 2022 and November 2022.
- In the event any selection events are canceled for one reason or another, the AFA reserves the option to designate, with reasonable notice, a substitute event. If another sanctioned event is not available as an option, the Alberta Fencing Association reserves the option to organize and host an unsanctioned Canada games selection tournament event. If an alternate event is not provided, the potential qualification points from the event will be void.
- Selection will be based on **Canada Winter Games Qualification Points**, which will be tracked independently of AFA Provincial Ranking points and updated on the AFA website and through official communication channels.
- Athletes will be given points on their best 4 results in the Cadet event of the 6 qualifying tournaments. Qualifying tournaments include:
 1. CWG Selection Event 1 (March 13, 2022);
 2. Leslie Palmai Open 2022;
 3. Alberta Provincial Fencing Championships 2022;
 4. TBD one more event in 2021/2022 season pending event confirmation; and
 5. **Up to 3** (pending 2021-2022 event confirmation) additional selection events in the first half of the 2022-2023 season to be determined and announced after the AFA event application deadline of next season.
- Points will be assigned based on results at qualifying tournaments listed above. Point values will be determined as per chart below, with points for Alberta Provincial Championships 2022 doubled. All tournaments aside from Provincial Championships 2022 will be weighted equally, unless specifically stated otherwise.

- No out-of-province tournaments will count towards selection points.
- The fencer with the highest number of CWG Qualification Points for each event will be selected to be on the team, assuming they meet all other qualifications. In the event that two fencers have an equal number of points, selection will be based on the following:
 1. If still tied, best cumulative results (up to 4 tournaments) at Alberta Cup tournaments
 2. Fencer with the highest number of First Place results at qualifying tournaments (Cadet event only)
 3. If still tied, best result at 2022 Provincial Championships (in Cadet event)
 4. If further tiebreaker is necessary, it will be handled by the Athlete Selection Committee
- Athletes must participate in mandatory training camps created to prepare for the Games. These camps will be announced in advance and advertised as such. Athletes may be excused from this requirement in the event of exceptional circumstances
- In the event that disciplinary sanction and/or removal is required, the Athlete Selection Committee will follow the process outlined in Section 3 of the AFA Policies and Procedures Manual.
- Athletes have the option of declining their selection. The next highest-ranked fencer on the Official Selection rankings will then be selected for the team.
