Appendix 4A: Approved Tournament Subsidies

The following subsidies have been provisionally approved for the 2024/25 tournament season.

Subsidies are only available to those host clubs that meet the sanctioning requirements as defined by AFA Policy and when supported by a receipt, proof of payment, or other acceptable backing as determined by the AFA ED.

Subsidies may be adjusted by the AFA Board of Directors prior to the season start (September), as required by the annual budget cycle and to optimize support for fencing in Alberta, at which time such changes will be communicated to Tournament Host Clubs.

Level 0 Tournaments:

- There are no subsidies available for Level 0 Tournaments at this time.

Level 1 Tournaments:

- An Officials Subsidy of 50% of Officials Honoraria as determined by the Officials Pay Schedule (Appendix 4D).
- A Medical Subsidy equal to the cost of one or more duly qualified medical personnel up to a maximum of \$750 per full day of competition.

Level 2 Tournaments:

- An Officials Subsidy of 50% of Officials Honoraria as determined by the Officials Pay Schedule (Appendix 4D).
- A Medical Subsidy equal to the cost of one or more duly qualified medical personnel up to a maximum of \$750 per full day of competition.
- A Medals Subsidy equal to the cost of the tournament medals up to a maximum of \$500.

Level 3 Tournaments:

- An Officials Subsidy of 50% of Officials Honoraria as determined by the Officials Pay Schedule (Appendix 4D).
- A Medical Subsidy equal to the cost of one or more duly qualified medical personnel up to a maximum of \$750 per full day of competition.
- No Medals Subsidy will be available for Level 3 Tournaments as medals will be provided by the AFA.
